Section 10.03 Vacating Party Office When A Candidate or Campaign Staffer in Primaries

Any officer of any precinct, county, congressional district, state executive committee, or state executive council who (1) files for a partisan elective office and who is opposed in the Democratic Primary or (2) ~~manages~~ is a paid member of a campaign staff for a candidate in a partisan elective office who is opposed in the Democratic Primary or (3) is a treasurer appointed for campaign reporting purposes in support of a candidate in a partisan elective office who is opposed in the Democratic primary, shall be deemed to have vacated that office as of the date that another Democrat files for the same elective office. Such vacancy shall be filled as provided for in this Plan of Organization.

~~Any officer of any county, congressional district, or state executive committee, who takes an active campaign managerial or staff role or is a treasurer appointed for campaign reporting purposes in support of a candidate in a partisan elective office who is opposed in the Democratic primary, shall be deemed to have vacated that office as of the date such candidate and another Democrat file for the same elective office. Such vacancy shall be filled as provided for in this Plan of Organization.~~
