FRANCISCO PUBLISHES A DISTRICT MAGAZINE!

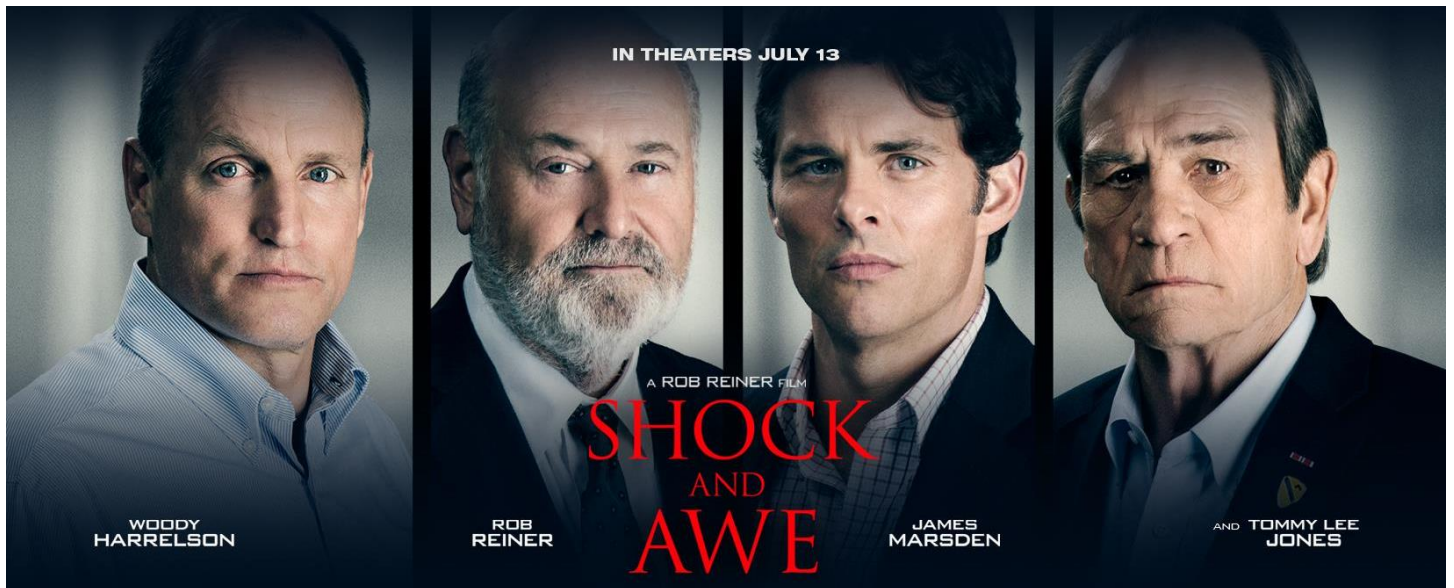

A unique holiday exercise: Libby Ann is throwing pies at the painting of a British soldier. Wynn is watching carefully.

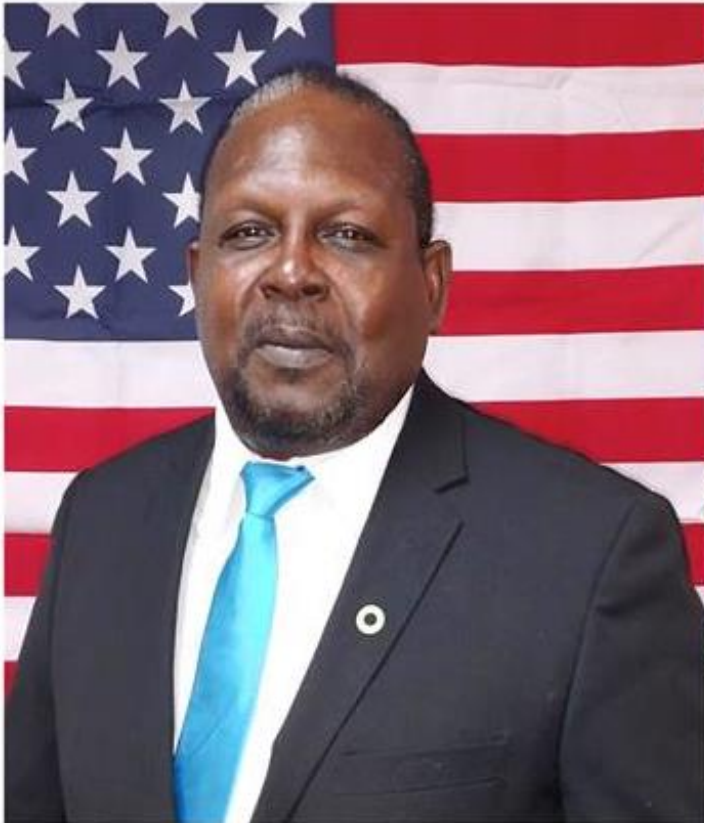
The writing at the top of the painting invites children to "Pie The Redcoat!"

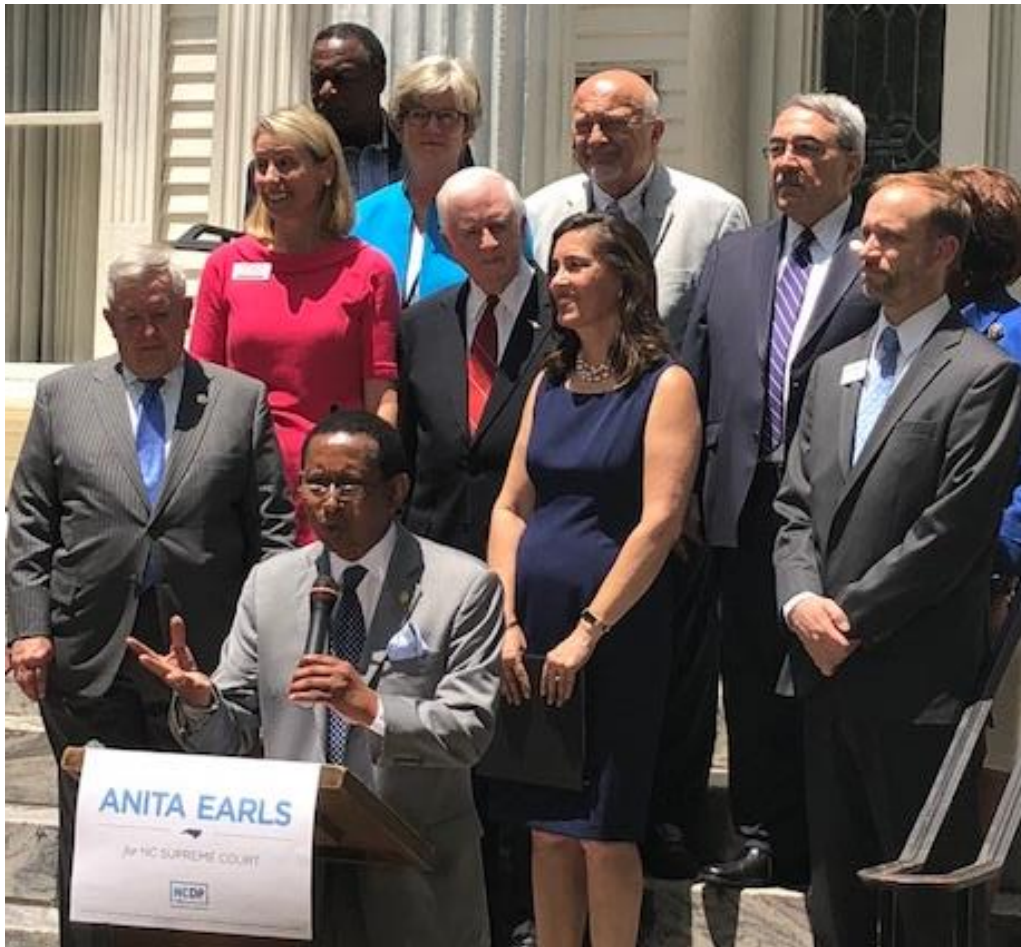
