COLE PHELPS AWARDS 11 SCHOLARSHIPS!

State Senate candidate – and Washington County Commissioner – D. Cole Phelps awarded eleven Scholarships for \$1,000.00 each before a crowd of 300 in Williamston on July 13th!

This is the fifth year that Cole has presented scholarships. That is remarkable for a man who is only 28 years old! He was elected County Commissioner at age 23 and has already been re-elected to a second term.

Democrats all across North Carolina are cheering for Cole as he runs for State Senate in District One which includes 11 counties in the northeastern corner of the state!






