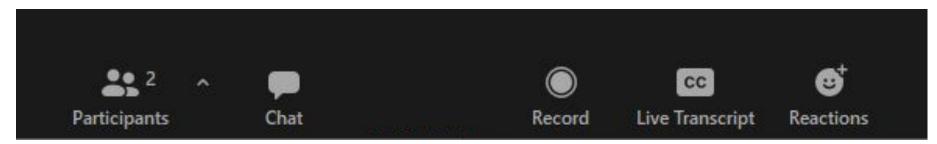

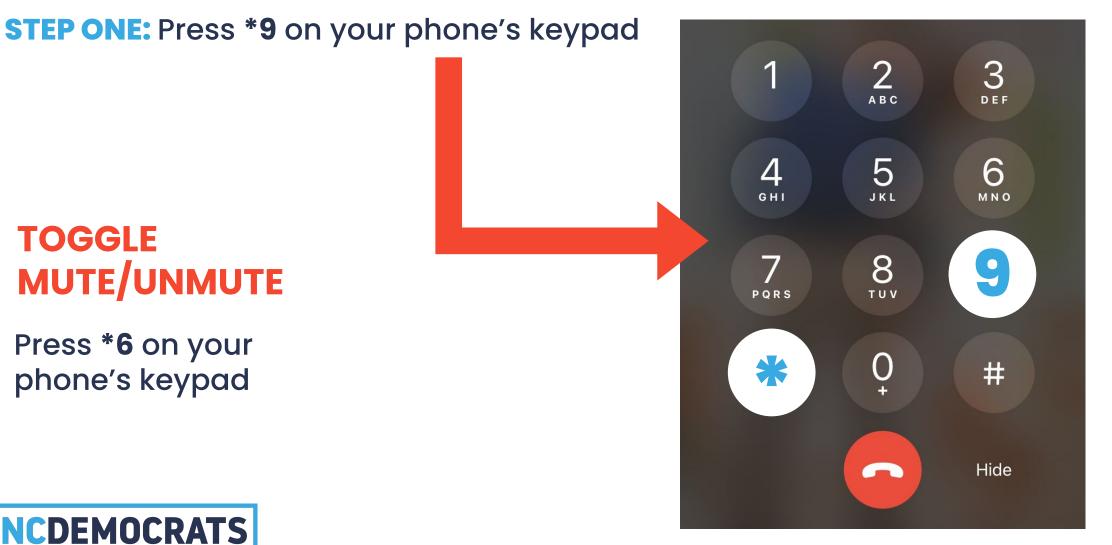



#### WHAT ARE THE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN ZOOM & MOBILIZE?

- Zoom is cloud-based communication resource used for video/audio conferences and collaborative capabilities.



## BEST PRACTICES FOR ONLINE TRAINING

#### **Visual Learners**

• Visual learners are those who prefer learning by observing things. Using pictures, images, diagrams, whiteboards etc. helps these types of learners understand information better (*i.e.Use of graphs to show voter turnout percentages*).

#### **Auditory Learners**

• Auditory learners retain information through hearing and speaking. They often prefers to be told how to do things and then summarizes the main points out loud to help with memorization (*i.e. listening to verbal instructions*)

#### **Kinesthetic Learners**

• Kinesthetic learners are hands-on, participatory learners who need to take a physically active role in the learning process in order to achieve their best educational outcomes. They tend to engage all of their senses equally in

### **TIPS FOR HOSTING AN ONLINE TRAINING**

#### **Online Training Skills**

- Research and/or survey for participants needs and Interest (Google Forms)
- Choose a video media platform (*i.e. Zoom, Google Meets*, Microsoft Teams)
- Invite co-host to assist with meeting duties
- Create a script or outline for the training
- Utilize Visual aids to assist with comprehension of training topic *(i.e. slide decks)*

#### Develop


• Develop an action plan with your team, select key priorities for improvement ,set expectations but most importantly have passion for your purpose.


