NCDP is seeking highly motivated candidates to serve as Eva Clayton Regional Organizing Fellows in our Congressional Districts. Organizers will focus on voter engagement and building long-term grassroots teams and organizing capacity. Regional Organizing Fellows will focus on day-to-day field operations in their assigned regions and will be responsible for implementing a portion of the field plan—recruiting, training, and managing County Captains, Grassroot Organizers, and volunteers. Fellows will be required to attend weekly statewide organizing meetings. Organizers will be held accountable for meeting both quantitative and qualitative field metrics. Ideal candidates must be able to complete tasks on tight deadlines.

### **Political:**

The Political Department organizes and problem-solves with our most important asset – NCDP volunteers and activists! These volunteers/activists are the on-the-ground Democratic leaders in their communities. These volunteers/activists are comprised of county chairs, auxiliary presidents, district chairs, etc., and they are spread out across the entire state. If you want to know how grassroots North Carolina politics works, this is the department for you. As the Political fellow you'll be tasked with answering constituent phone calls, responding to concerns from Democrats all over the state, helping other departments as they work with our community leaders – to gain real insight into the NCDP and how it functions in communities across the state.
