


# A SALUTE TO KRISTIN COOPER!

### HENDERSON COUNTY SIGNS TELL THE TRUTH!





# PROFESSOR GENE NICHOL & BRANDON GRAY SPEAK TO DEMOCRATIC BOOK CLUB!

The Guilford County Democratic Book
Club hosted Gene Nichol, renowned
constitutional attorney, author, Professor
of Law at UNC, and Brandon Gray, Vice
Chair of the Guilford Party and candidate
in NC House District 62.

The club met at Scuppernong Books in Greensboro.

Professor Nichol discussed his book "Indecent Assembly: The NC Legislature's Blueprint for the War on Democracy." It is his most recent book and it tells what we as Democrats need to do to stop the GOP's war on democracy, our justice system, people of color, the poor, and women.

"Indecent Assembly" is a detailed history and critique of the Republican Party's gerrymandered takeover of the North Carolina Assembly and the disastrous results. Professor Nichol pointed out that this is not just a political wave. This is a war on democracy. He said that we have to do whatever we can to prevent the Republicans from attaining a super majority in North Carolina. If Republicans get a super majority, they can override the Governor's veto, leaving us helpless to their often unpopular and sometimes draconian laws.

Professor Nichol said that Democrats must encourage people to vote for Democratic judges in order to keep our liberties and protect reproductive rights in North Carolina.



Brandon Gray closed the program with a summary of his campaign platform including Medicaid expansion, opening hospitals in rural areas, improving public schools, and insuring that all North Carolinians are treated equally.
