His speech was part of his nationwide campaign to highlight investments and legislation, including the bipartisan CHIPS Act that is aimed at promoting clean energy.





During the President's speech he announced that Wolfspeed's investment in Chatham County is expected to create 1,800 jobs that pay an average of \$77,000 by 2030.

The President also announced that a company named VinFast will invest \$4 billion in a new Chatham County facility that will make electric buses, electric SUVs, and electric vehicle batteries. They expect to hire 7,500 workers and produce 150,000 vehicles per year.

He further announced that Toyota is making a \$3.8 billion investment in a new lithium-ion battery manufacturing plant in Liberty, NC – creating 2,100 new jobs. That company is also putting \$1 million toward workforce readiness opportunities.
